## **Creating a Table in Weebly**

- 1. Create your table with the content you will be adding to your website in a word document. Includes your links to sites and resources in the table too.
- 2. Save your document as your "first initial, last name, webtable". It is *very important* that you save your document as a .doc, in case you want to go back and make corrections!
- 3. Now you will do a Save As keeping the same file name but as a web page (\*.htm, \*.html)
- 4. Close the web page version of your document and then re open it. This version will open as a web page; you should no longer see any word tool bars at the top of the page.
- 5. In the menu bar at the top of the page click on *View>Source*. This will open a window which contains the source code for your table. Select all of the text (ctrl/cmd + a) and copy this text (ctrl/cmd+ c)
- 6. Open your Weebly site and click on the page you want your table to appear
- 7. From the Element tool bar select and drag Custom HTML onto your page
- 8. Paste (ctrl/cmd + v) into the element
- 9. Click on Publish to save and view
